


**STATEMENT OF EMERGENCY JUSTIFICATION
FOR THE
EMERGENCY OPPORTUNITY ACT RULES
7 CCR 1103-4**

§ 8-1-107(2)(p) and § 8-2-126, C.R.S. (2013), provide the Director of the Division of Labor with the authority to adopt rules and regulations pertaining to the implementation of the Colorado Employment Opportunity Act.

Pursuant to §24-4-103(6), C.R.S. (2013), The Division of Labor has made a finding that adopting the Emergency Rules is imperatively necessary to comply with state and federal law and for the preservation of public health, safety, and welfare and that compliance with the requirements of the Colorado Administrative Procedure Act would be contrary to the public interest.

The Division of Labor is adopting the Emergency Opportunity Act Rules on this date, Wednesday, January 08, 2014. The Emergency Opportunity Act Rules are effective immediately.
