EMERGENCY RULEMAKING JUSTIFICATION

These changes are created to align the Director's Procedures with the state personnel system's Paid Family Medical Leave (PFML) policies created by the State Personnel Director under the authority of §24-50-104(1)(g), C.R.S. and become effective as of January 13, 2021.

The State Personnel Director is exercising her rulemaking authority as granted under one or more of the following: Executive Order 2020 003; 24-33.5-701 et seq, C.R.S; Article XII of the Colorado Constitution.

These emergency rules shall go into effect January 13, 2021. A permanent rulemaking hearing regarding these rules has been scheduled for February 5, 2021 and the rules are anticipated to be placed into permanent rules as of April 1, 2021. Pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act C.R.S. §24-4-103(6), an emergency rule can only be in effect for a maximum of 120 days.
