EMERGENCY RULEMAKING JUSTIFICATION

This version reflects emergency changes to Chapter 5, Time Off that become effective on August 7, 2023. A permanent rulemaking hearing will be conducted on September 29, 2023.

The justification for the emergency changes to this section of Chapter 5, Time Off, are to align the Director's Procedures with the requirements of SB 23-017, and are made under the Personnel Director's authority found at one or more of the following: §24-50-104(1)(g), C.R.S., §24-33.5-701 et seq, C.R.S, and/or Article XII of the Colorado Constitution.

This emergency rule shall go into effect August 7, 2023. Pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act, C.R.S. §24-4-103(6), an emergency rule can only be in effect for a maximum of 120 days.

The State Personnel Director's Administrative Procedures are found at 4 CCR 801-1.
