On Wednesday January 20, 2021, at 10:00 a.m., the Division of Water Resources will hold a public rulemaking hearing, pursuant to section 24-4-103(4)(a), C.R.S., before the Hearing Officer for the State Engineer ("Hearing Officer") via Zoom conferencing. At the hearing, the Hearing Officer will afford interested parties an opportunity to submit and present written or oral data, views, or arguments for consideration by the Hearing Officer. # To Apply for Party Status

- Party status applications must include the name, U.S. mail address, telephone number, and email address of the Person, Persons, or Agency seeking Party Status
- The application shall also indicate the interest of the Person(s) or Agency in the proposed rules and a description of the general nature of the evidence to be presented by the proposed Party in the course of the proceedings.
- Party status applications must be submitted via email as a .pdf to the Hearing Officer, <a href="jody.grantham@state.co.us">jody.grantham@state.co.us</a> by December 10, 2020.
- If you submit a complete Application for Party Status by the above the deadline, you will be granted party status.
- If you do not submit an Application for Party Status by the above noticed deadline, you may still be given an opportunity to provide comments during the hearing as an interested person, but you may not be granted party status, and the time to present your comments may be limited.

- Prehearing Statement are <u>due no later than December 16, 2020</u> and are to be filed via email in .pdf format with <u>jody.grantham@state.co.us</u>
- The Prehearing Statement shall include:
  - a. A specific statement of the factual and legal claims it asserts;
  - b. Copies of all exhibits it will introduce at the hearing;
  - c. A list of witnesses to be called and a brief summary of their testimony;
  - d. Specific language proposed for the rule, where appropriate, and a proposed basis and purpose for the rule; and
  - e. All written testimony that will be offered into evidence at the hearing.

## Order Governing Participation in the Rulemaking Hearing

- Following the prehearing conference the hearing officer will issue an order governing participation in the hearing.
- The Order will be distributed to the <u>Nontributary Groundwater Rules Rulemaking 2020</u> <u>Notification List</u> and all parties who applied for party status, and posted on the DWR Website.
- The Order will allot specific times for party testimony on each specific proposed rule.
- Length of testimony allotted is reserved entirely to the discretion of the Hearing Officer.
