

#### 5.2.7 Upper Big Sandy Designated Ground Water Basin - Alluvial Aquifer

5.2.7.1 The Alluvial Aquifer shall be defined as the area identified in Figure 3 "Interpolated Saturated Alluvial Extent" of the report entitled Upper Big Sandy Designated Groundwater Basin – Phase 2 Water Balance Report June 2009, by Martin and Wood Water Consultants, Inc. ~~Plate 1 of the report entitled, "Geology and Ground Water Resources of Parts of Lincoln, Elbert, and El Paso Counties, Colorado," by the Colorado Water Conservation Board and the U.S. Geological Survey, Denver, Colorado, 1946.~~

5.2.7.2 The Alluvial Aquifer within the Upper Big Sandy Designated Basin is determined to be overappropriated and, therefore, no new large capacity well permits shall be granted in the Alluvial Aquifer unless a replacement plan is approved by the Commission in accordance with Rule 5.6.~~A new large capacity well permit can be granted by the Commission to appropriate water from the Alluvial Aquifer identified above in Rule 5.2.7.1 if this appropriation does not unreasonably impair any existing water rights.~~
