Colorado Secretary of State

Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

Article XVI of the Constitution of the State state of Colorado is amended BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION to read:

Section 9.5.5. No public use of water overlying private property. The Public Has NO RIGHT TO THE USE OF NON-NAVIGABLE SHALL NOT USE NONNAVIGABLE WATERS OVERLYING PRIVATE PROPERTY WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE OWNER OF THE PRIVATE PROPERTY.
