
Law in 2020

- Legislation passed in 2019 session (SB19-202)
 - Access electronically delivered ballot
 - Print and return ballot by 7PM



Use in 2020 General Election

- Use in 2020
 - 204 individuals accessed
 - 83 reported returned
 - Arapahoe, 27
 - Denver, 14
 - 22913 UOCAVA ballots accessed
 - 469 Emergency ballots accessed






Changes in 2021

- Legislation passed in 2021 session (SB 21-188)
 - Still access electronically delivered ballot
 - Voter with "print disability" can now return using secure document return (UOCAVA)
 - Voters can return acceptable form of ID in lieu of signature (similar to in-person)
 - Other voters print and return
 - Available for all statewide elections beginning this November



Use in 2021

- 205 individuals accessed
 - 96 Emergency ballot
 - 7132 UOCAVA ballot



Still working through data for final numbers on ballots returned
