### STATEMENT OF INSUFFICIENCY

August 1, 2022

On July 14, 2022, Drew Haugen, an unaffiliated candidate for Colorado State House of Representatives, District 53, submitted 1,087 petition signatures to the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office. The candidate seeks nomination by petition to the November 8, 2022, general election ballot. Under Colorado law, Mr. Haugen's petition must contain at least 1,000 valid signatures.<sup>1</sup>

#### Petition Verification Summary:

The Secretary of State has determined that Mr. Haugen submitted an insufficient number of valid signatures and will not be placed on the 2022 general election ballot. A public record of all accepted and rejected signatures is on file at the Elections Division of the Secretary of State's office.
