NOTARY PUBLIC RENEWAL CHECKLIST

This checklist is to help you gather all of your documents before you start your filing. The following documents must be scanned and uploaded during the application filing process.

Affirmation (PDF)

- Form is provided after this checklist.
- Signed by you in front of a notary.
- There can be no blank/unfilled spaces.
- Applicant's name must exactly match applicant's driver's license.
- Notary must use "Notary public" as their title.

For U.S. citizens: ID Card

Do not upload your social security card.

One of the following types of ID:

- Front and back of a current Colorado driver's license or Colorado ID card.
- Signed U.S. passport.
- Current Bureau of Indian Affairs Card or Tribal ID.
- Current military ID card or common access card that has your photograph.
- Out of state driver's license or state ID card.

Make sure that the information on your ID is legible, and that the scan is right-side up.

If you have a Colorado driver's license or ID card (issued by the Dept. of Revenue), you can enter your ID number during the Attachments step instead of scanning and attaching a copy.

For Non-U.S. citizens: Permanent resident card or Employment Authorization Document (EAD) card

You must also include your lawful presence documentation if you have either:

- a Colorado issued Part 5 ID card, or
- an out of state driver's license that is valid for identification or federal purposes.

Copy both sides. Make sure that the information on your ID is legible, and that the scan is right-side up.



Training Certificate

- Issued within the last 90 days by a state- approved trainer.
- Training can be completed with our office.
- Print and save your certificate showing that you passed.




Exam Certificate

- Issued within the last 90 days by our office.
- Do not attach printouts of the exam questions.
- Print and save your certificate showing that you passed.

The following remote notary specific documents must be scanned and uploaded during the application filing process.


Remote Notary Affirmation (PDF)

- Form is provided after this checklist.
- Signed by you in front of a notary.
- There can be no blank/ unfilled spaces.
- Notary must use "Notary public" as their title.

Remote Notary Training & Exam certificate

- Remote notary specific training & exam certificate issued by our office within the last 90 days.
- Do not attach printouts of the exam questions.
- Print and save your certificate showing that you passed.

Intent to notarize electronically (eNotary)

If you are currently approved to notarize electronically and want to continue you'll need to attach an updated Intent to notarize electronically (PDF) form.



Make sure you are using the most recent form. If this is not the most recent form, the Department of State will be unable to process any portion of your application.

If you are registering to become or renewing a notary commission, you will be referred to as "Applicant". If you are notarizing the affirmation, you will be referred to as "Notary".

Applicant: The person registering or renewing a notary commission.

Type your name as it appears on your government issued identification. (Ex: driver's license)

Note: Your middle name or suffix is optional.

Notary: Individual with a current notary commission issued by the state of Colorado. Failure to correctly notarize this document may be grounds for admonishment.

- 3. Write the county where the notarization is taking place
- 4. Write today's Day and Month
- 5. Write today's Year
- 6. Write the name of the applicant that signed the document.
- 7. Sign the affirmation using your official signature.
- 8. Write your RULONA Title. This must be one of the following:
 - a. Notary Public
 - b. Clerk
 - c. Deputy Clerk.
 - d. Judge.
- 9. Stamp the document ensuring the stamp is COMPLETELY in the white space at the bottom.
- 10. Complete a journal entry for this notarization.
