Greetings,

Please make note of the concerns below in revising Colorado's election rules:

- Please clarify Amended Rule 2.5.4 to specify that in election years of both presidential
 and state primaries, voter party affiliation applies only to a single primary, not all
 primaries in the cycle.
- Reject Amended Rule 2.13.2, which would eliminate the requirement of election judges to maintain a log of new registered voters or of any changes made by registered electors. These actions are critical to maintaining the integrity of fair and honest elections.
- Reject Amended Rule 8, which would forbid poll watchers from having electronic devices or mobile phones. How else can they report voting irregularities in real time?
- For Ballot Separation Options for Unaffiliated Voters, I prefer Option 1, which would allow unaffiliated voters to receive major party ballots, with the return envelope providing a method for the county to identify the party. Furthermore, I ask that the SoS take steps to create a failsafe method for ensuring voter anonymity.
- Cross Jurisdiction Voting: While creating a mechanism for allowing cross-county voting seems like a good idea, it could encourage counties to reduce the number of voting centers by shifting to other counties. Please clarify to include measures to ensure this does not happen.
