I read the Notice PDF and all current posted comments but some topics of concern, which may not be defined or are going too deep into the nitty-gritty of, within the Preliminary Draft of Proposed Rules dated 15May2020 are:

First, on current temporary rule adopted 8May2020, 7.2.17., what is the impact to voters for a surveillance system that captures an act or event where a drop box's contents are placed into question? Are votes from that location voided and are voters notified they get to cast another vote and, should that be the procedure, how is this accounted for to make sure two votes from the same individual are not tallied?

Second, on current temporary rule adopted 8May2020, pages 3-4 of 6, SS 4-6, is the device referenced for users electronically polling or is it in reference to the database where the records are kept? And if it is in regards to a voting/polling machine or kiosk, are those kiosks desired to be (or will be) connected to the internet, an Ethernet, or by standalone? Additionally IF such machines are connected to the internet, would this affect UOCAVA voters as a new voting option to link into such system via a secured web page?
