At any time during early voting, voting on Nov. 3, 2020, or post election activities such as tallying statewide votes, was any data uploaded to Dominion systems or components residing outside of the Colorado State network?

At any time during early voting, voting on Nov. 3, 2020, or post election activities such as tallying statewide votes were Dominion employees allowed in person access to the Colorado Voting System?

At any time during early voting, voting on Nov. 3, 2020, or post election activities such as tallying statewide votes were Dominion employees granted remote access privliges to the Colorado State network or voting systems?

With the addition of section 27, how were observers allowed to inspect signatures on mail-in ballots considering the 6 foot distancing requirement in section 27?
